**34<sup>th</sup> Annual Over-the-Log-Championship** One shot per target is fired from the prone position with a rest @ 48 yds. Scoring is based on the best 10 of 30 targets. Daily plaques are awarded for the best 3 shots of the day. Top 3 places in the match are awarded plaques. This is a Blanket Shoot so all shooters have a choice of a many custom made and commercial prizes. Dinner is provided on Saturday night for contestants and their families.

**Registration Fee:** One blanket prize (suggested minimum value - \$10) plus \$35 for 30 targets.
